Terms & Conditions

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1. Introduction

2. About the Foundation

Stichting HPE Entrust Foundation is a Dutch foundation registered with the Chamber of Commerce (KvK) under number 42103057, RSIN 869743260. The Foundation’s mission is to promote high-quality, competency-based education and training in health professions worldwide, particularly in low- and middle-income countries, in support of better patient care and stronger health professions systems.
